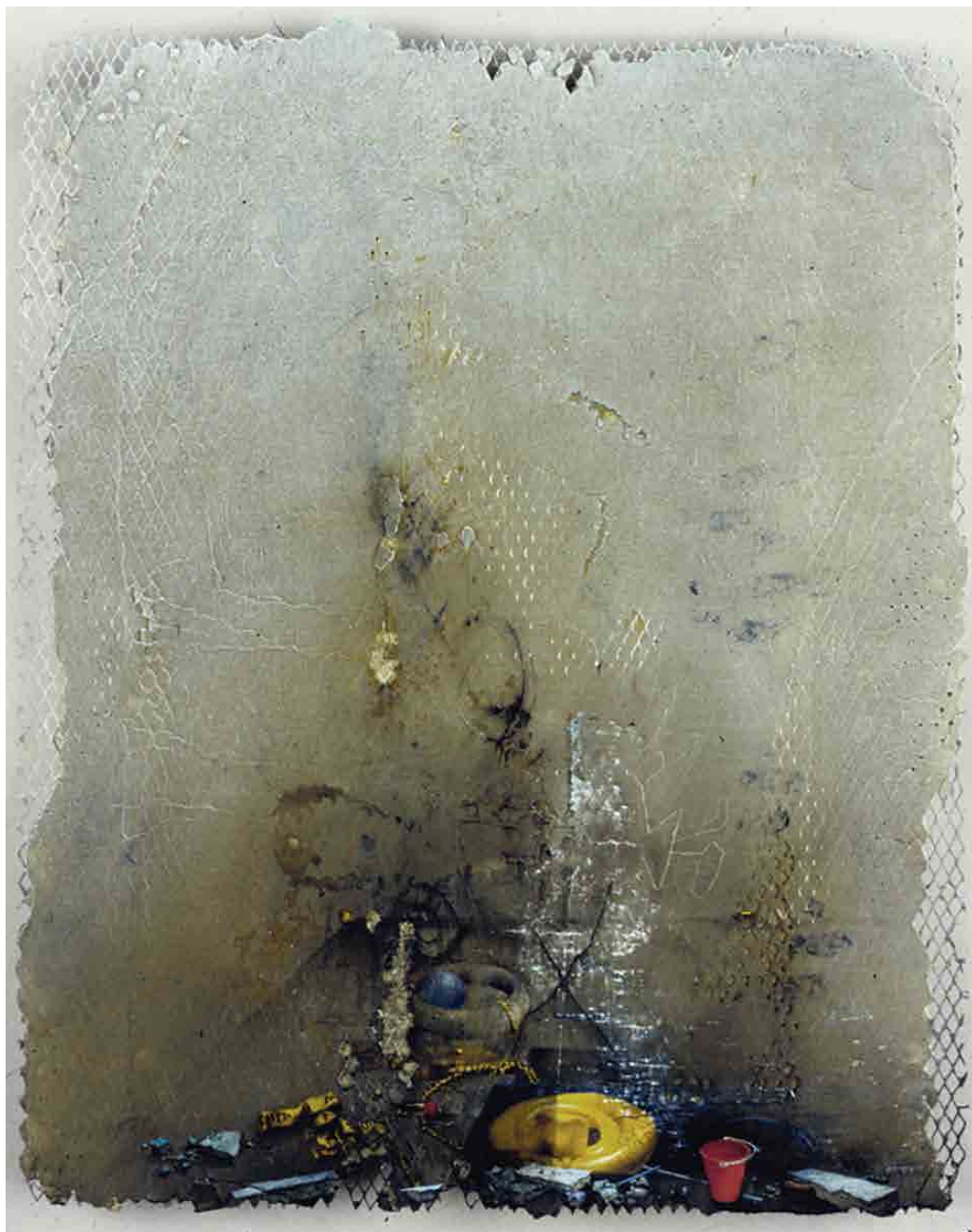

Antoinette Winters, *Extinct*, 2022. Acrylic on paper, 8x8 in.



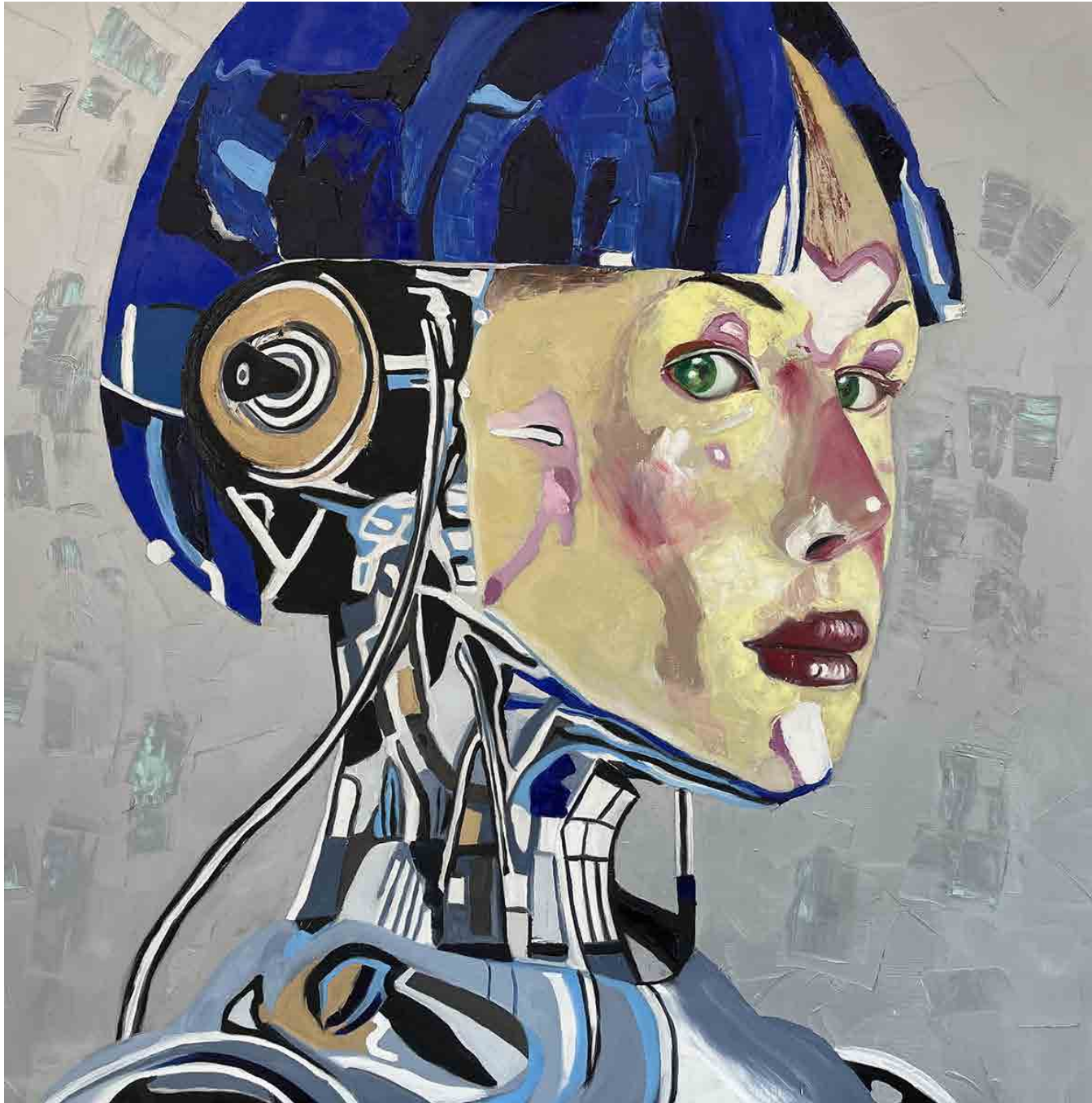

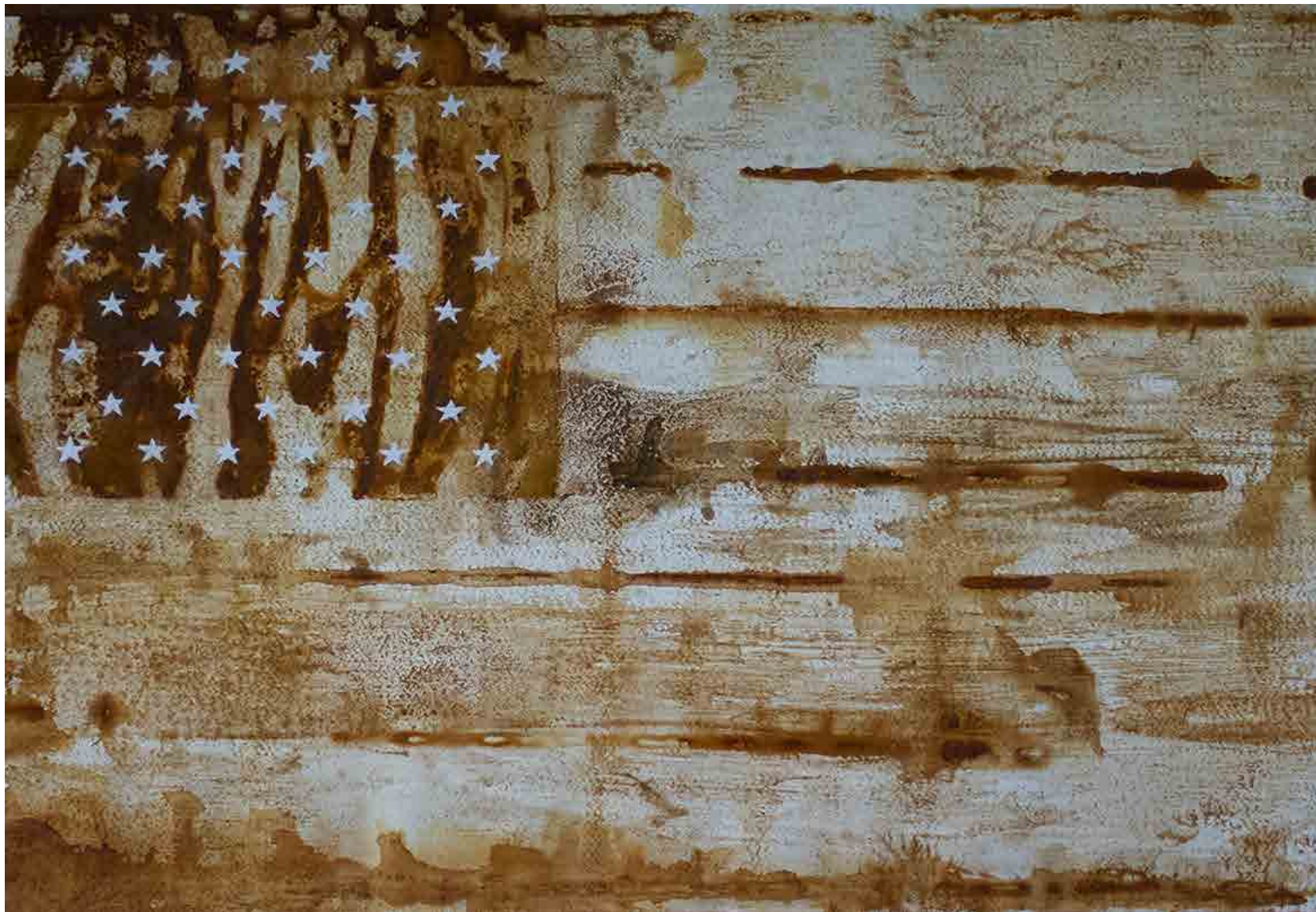

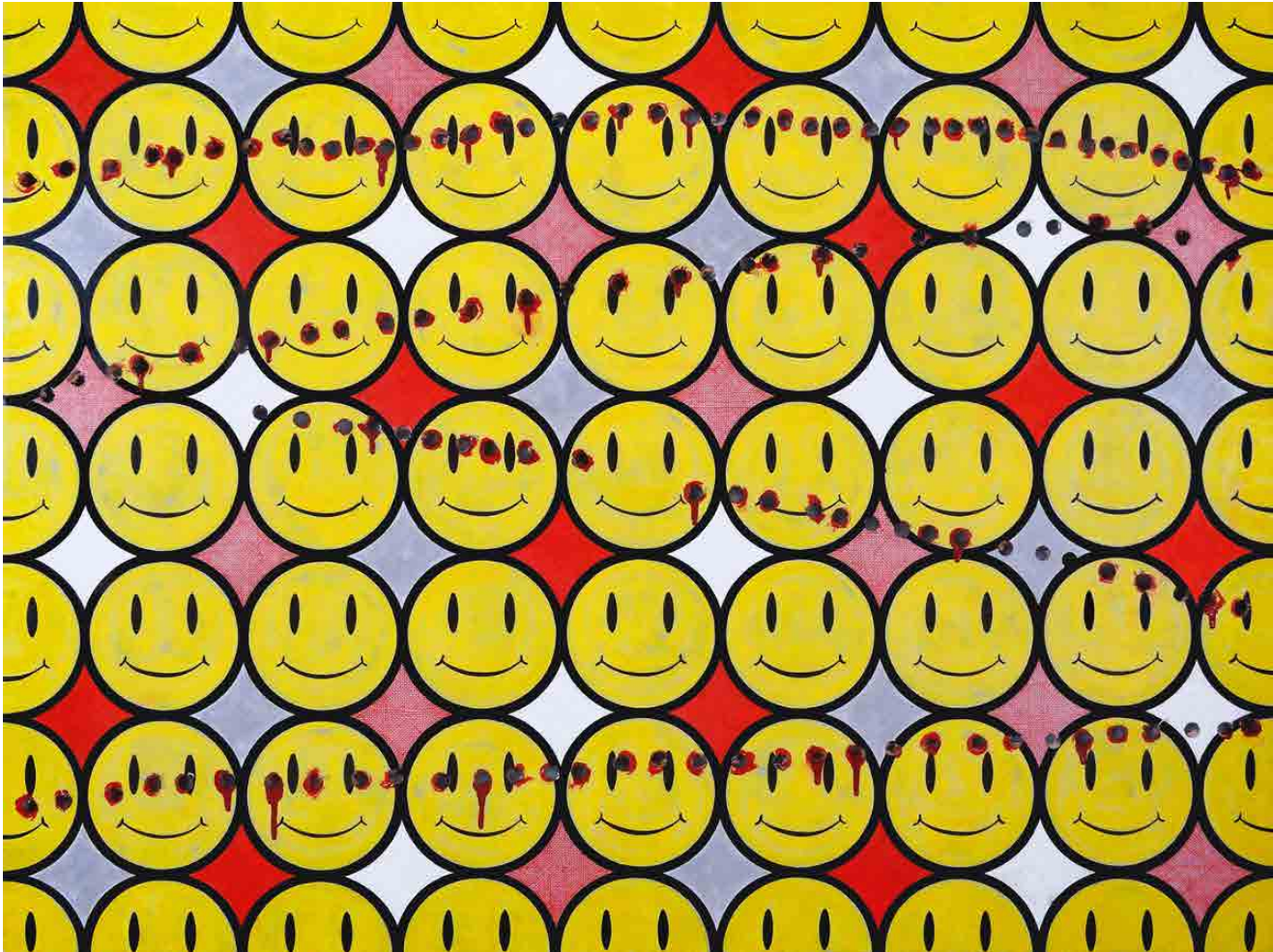

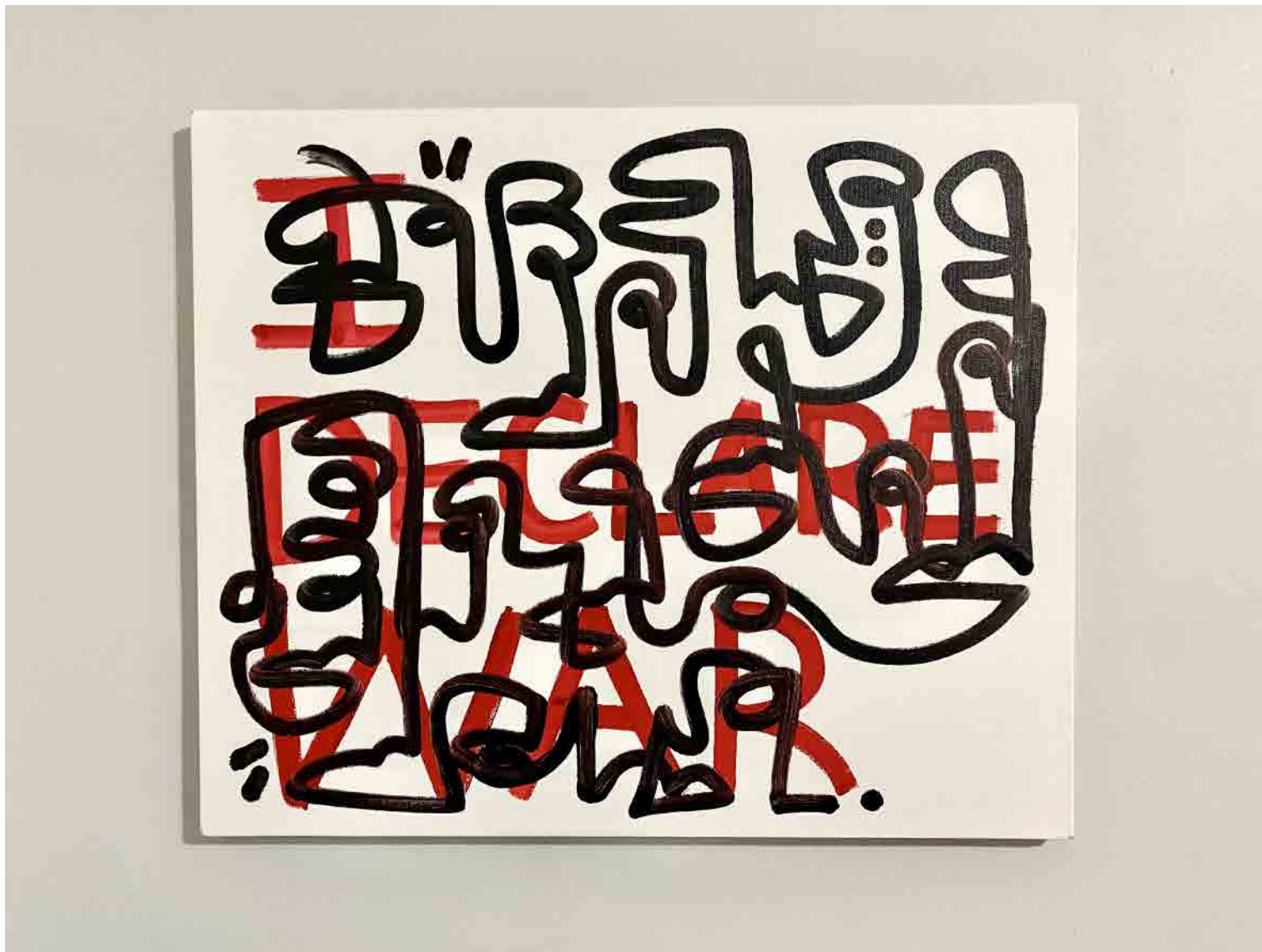

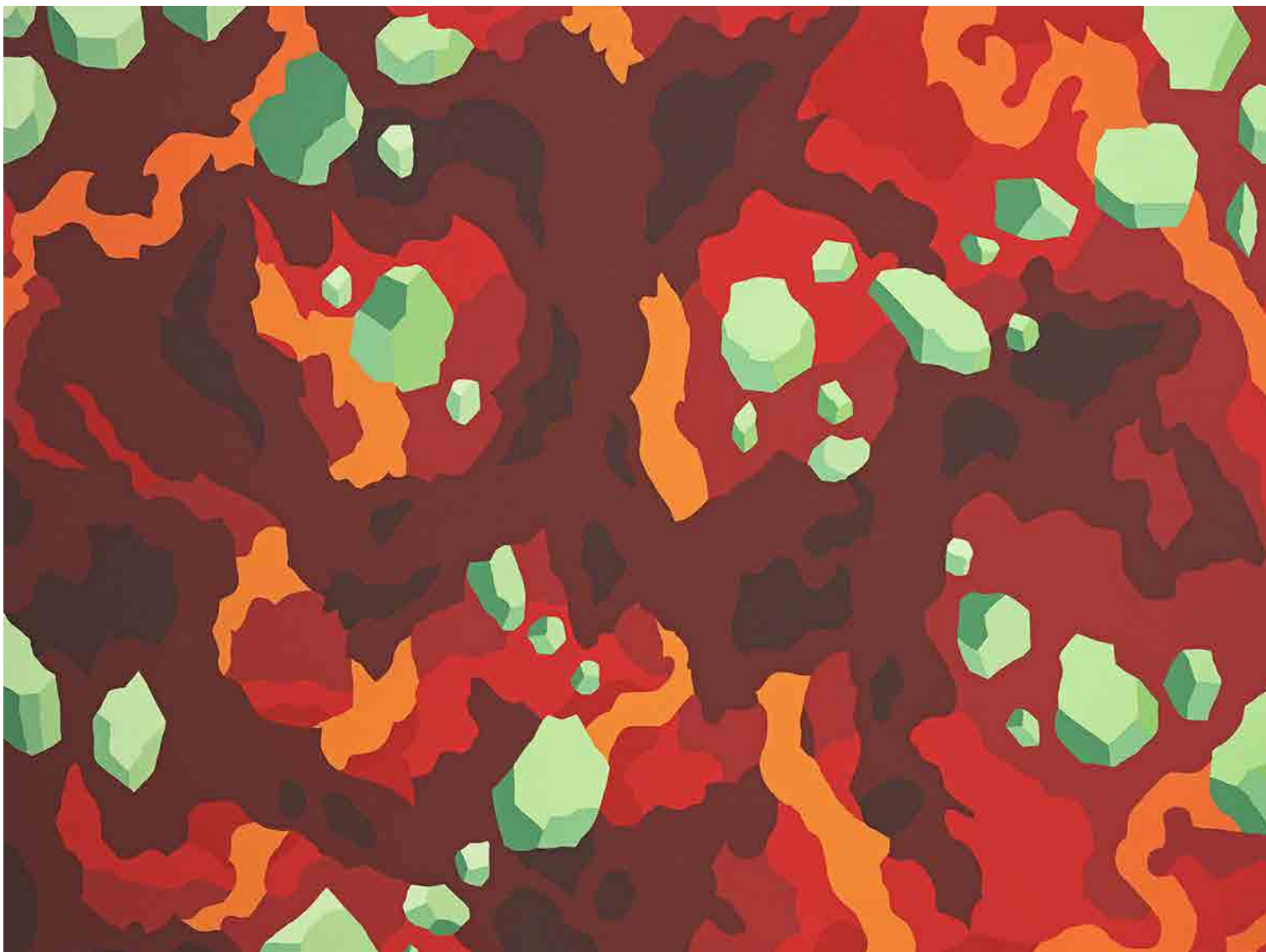

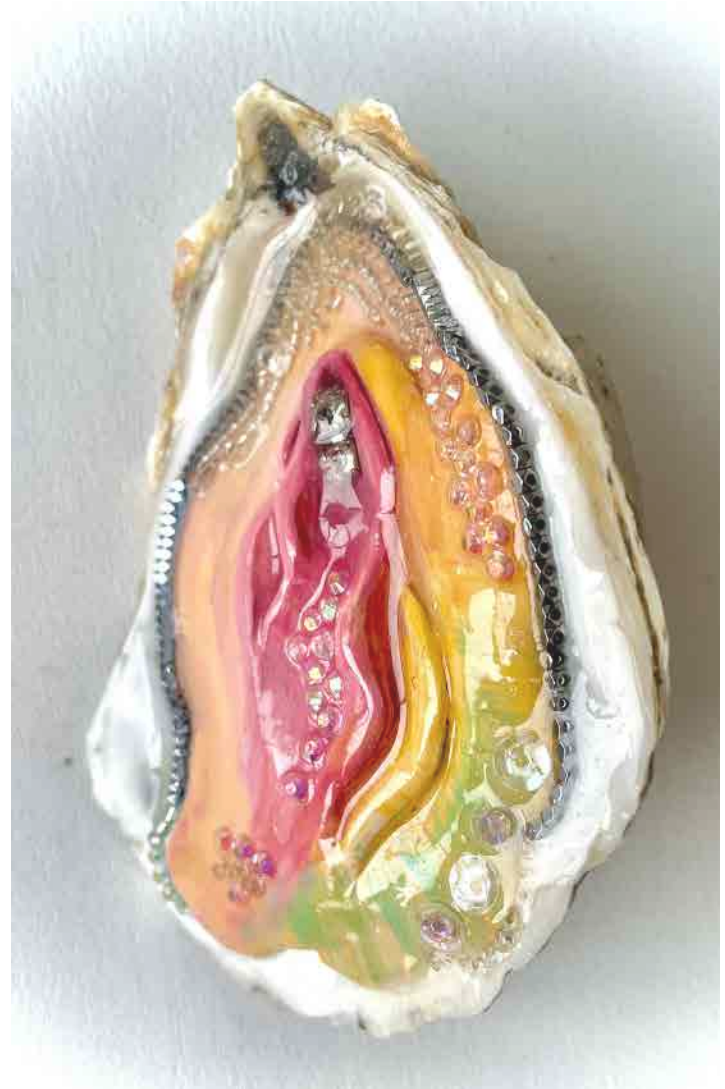

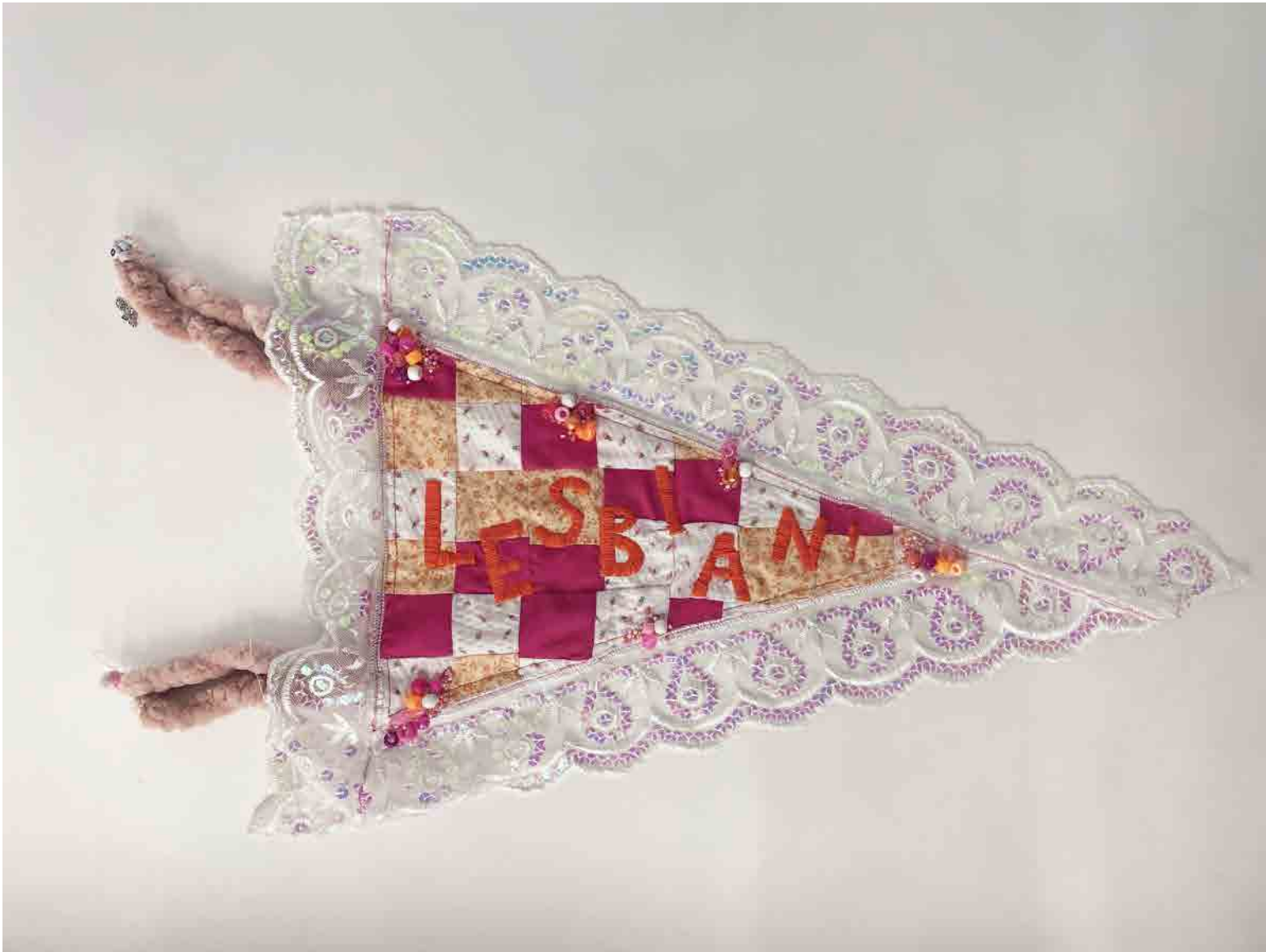

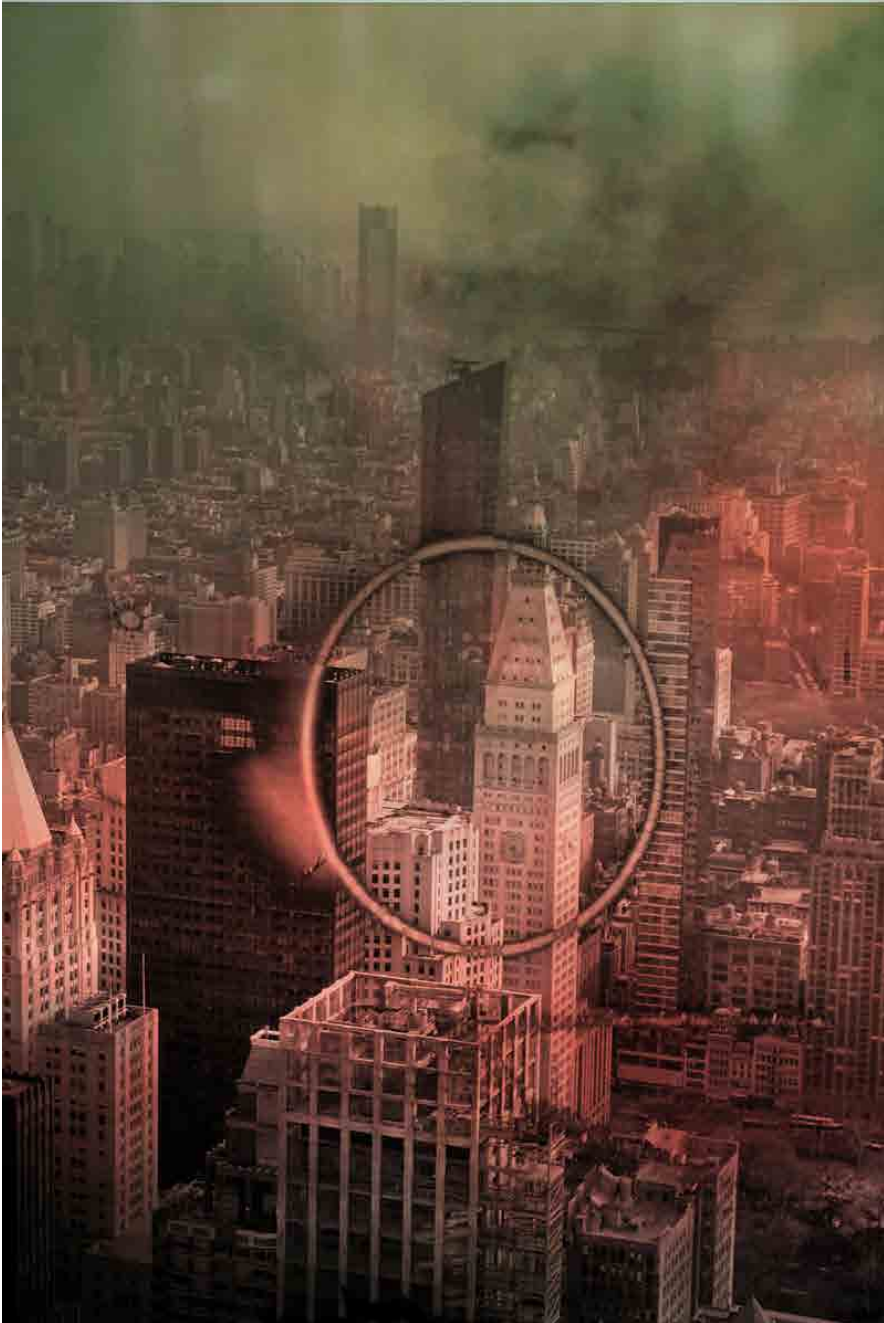
